- Respect equipment, belongings and facilities used
- Endeavour to do their best at both training sessions and race events
- Respect all coaches and to listen, follow instructions and advice given by them
- Challenge others with respect
- Think before posting any information online in the public domain, such as websites or social media
- Ensure that any profiles on Social Media and any content that you post are consistent with the image you represent in respect of your association with MIRC.

**MIRC does not expect those involved with the club to -**

- Bully others, including referring to them by names they do not wish to be known by.

- upload content onto websites or Social Media sites that could be deemed disruptive, threatening, abusive, harassing, libelous or an invasion of another's privacy; this includes text, audio, photography and video
- Use MIRC's name in a derogatory manner
- Upload any content deemed confidential to MIRC
- Use the MIRC logo without prior consent
- Use inappropriate hashtags on Twitter, Facebook, Instagram or other media platforms
- Post personal messages through MIRC pages on any social media platform
